Recently S/S Jeyaseelan was contacted by the staff at one of the mall's tenants about a male on the floor who was bleeding and not breathing.

S/S Jeyaseelan jumped into action, contacting 911 and approaching the individual. Utilizing his first aid skills, S/S Jeyaseelan assessed the situation and began CPR and use of the site's AED. After several minutes of compressions and three AED defibrillations, the man began breathing. This was just in time for Toronto EMS to arrive and continue First Aid Care.

His training, calm demeanor, and professionalism all shone through during this difficult event. S/S Jeyaseelan is commended for his actions and has has won the 2022 Q3 the Canadian Security Lifesaver Association award.

Team rescues toddler Sean Henry - Nicholas Baker - Ashlyn Proeller - Shannoy Campbell

On July 29th, 2022, Security Dispatch Coordinator Ashlyn Proeller received a call from the General Manager of the Moxie's located at Bramelea City Centre for a major medical incident.

S/D Proeller advised all available security to attend Moxie's and placed a call to 911 advising them of the situation.

Security Guard Sean Henry was the first to arrive. He observed a toddler wheezing and struggling to cough, advised the primary caretaker that he was first aid certified and asked if he could assist. S/G Henry administered multiple back blows to the toddler, who then began coughing loudly and crying. At this time Security Supervisors Nicholas Baker and Shannoy Campbell arrived.

S/S Campbell resumed back blows, as the toddler's cough became quiet, and it was believed the obstruction was again becoming an issue. They were successful in dislodging the obstruction from the toddler's throat.

Rapid Response arrived on scene and care of the toddler was swiftly transferred over. Rapid Response conducted an assessment and observed the toddler to have normal breathing and good vitals. EMS arrived on scene and transported the victim and primary caretaker to Brampton Civic Hospital for further assessment.
